Today we continue our work securing Divisions A, B, and C. As we move forward, we need to remain vigilant and disciplined in all areas of the fireline.

- **Dangerous Trees**: Be on the lookout for weakened, burned, or fire-scarred trees that could fall without warning. Avoid working directly under hazard trees whenever possible.

- **Ash Pits**: Stay alert for ash pits, especially in areas of heavy burn. These can cause severe burns and injuries if stepped into. Use tools to check questionable ground before committing your weight.

- **Heavy Equipment Work Areas**: Be aware of the dozer lines. Maintain safe space between personnel and equipment and keep escape routes clear.

- **Smoke Issues**: Smoke continues to be a concern across the divisions. Protect your respiratory health. N95 masks are available—make sure you're using them when needed, especially in heavy smoke pockets.

**Above all, keep safety as your top priority. Stay situationally aware, watch out for your crew, and report any hazards immediately to your supervisor.**

**Let's stay focused, look out for one another, and continue the good work securing this fire.**

# SS014 Fire Behaviour Forecast September 07

## Weather Synopsis

With the completion of the cold frontal passage by mid-morning the wind regime for the day is poised to be quite calm and variable. Though still higher than seasonal temperatures will stay below 20 today hitting a max of 18C, while the minimum RH is expected to be about 40%. Wind direction generally speaking will transition from northerly in the morning to southeasterly at night. Wind speeds will transition from 10G20 in the morning to 5G10 through most of the burning day, with afternoon and evening winds expected to be variable.

## Fire Behaviour General

Fire behaviour potential is significantly reduced today in the wake of the cold frontal passage. Minimal winds will mean fire in all fuel types will struggle to get into the crowns, though C-2 and C-4 still have the potential of 50% crown fraction burned.

**Safety concerns:** With the deep drought conditions that persist be very careful as you're working in recently burned areas as there is the potential for the development of deep ash pits in these conditions that are deeper than your boot height and can result in leg burns if accidentally stepped into.


