
7. GENERAL SAFETY MESSAGE

Self Check - How are you feeling about your work? How do you feel about regional events? Are you noticing your mind and body getting tired? Hydration? Sleep? If you're not doing well, please talk to someone.

- Watch for mental fatigue - smoke, camp life, inadequate sleep, and long nights on the fire incident all contribute to brain drain. Take breaks when required, pace yourself, stay hydrated.
- Work on uneven terrain – assess your footing with every step. Be aware of changing conditions from day to day even if you were working in the same area as before.
