

July 6th - Discovery date

July 6th - Initial assessment completed. One hectare in size.

July 8th - Reassess and decide to do limited action, bucket on fire, drop off Sahtu 1 to cut out a helipad and access to fire. Charter Sahtu 3 to Norman Wells.

July 09th - Sahtu 1 and sahtu 3 working fire with bucket support from ZFN
July 09th - Sahtu 1 and sahtu 3 working fire with bucket support from ZFN (long term)

July 10th - Sahtu 1 and Sahtu 3 with bucket support from ZFN (long term) and NAS (short term)

July 11th - Sahtu 1, Sahtu 3 and Sahtu 4 working fire with ZFN (long term) and NAS (short term). Six retardant drops from Electra to limit growth on downslope perimeter



July 12th - Sahtu 1, 3 and 4 and Deh Cho 5 working fire with bucket support from F-ZFN and G-YFS. Group1 CL-215's actioned fire approximately 14:00. All ground crews pulled from fireline at 17:00 due to very intense fire conditions and crew safety was a concern. CL-215's continued working fire into the evening.

July 13th - Sahtu 1, 3, 4; Deh Cho 5; SS6 and SS10 working jump fire on west flank with bucket support from F-ZFN and F-NOU. CL215's unable to action the fire for most of the day due to smoke conditions created by an inversion but were able to work the fire from 18:30 until 21:30.
