## Major Hazards and Risks:

- Fire Behavior
- Heavy Equipment
- Working near helicopter sling operations and bucket work
- Environmental

*Remember – Safety is No Accident.*

**Fire Behavior:** Moderate behavior today. Don't let your guard down. REMEMBER AND FOLLOW: the *Standard Fire Orders*, the *Watchout Situations*, the *Common Denominators*, and *LACES* (Lookouts, Anchor Points, Communications, Escape Routes, and Safety Zones).

**Transportation:** All helicopter passengers must wear proper PPP and receive a safety briefing prior to flight.

**Helicopter Operations:** Keep crews above and clear of all bucket work because the downwash can cause snags to fall, break limbs out of trees, and the drop can knock people down or worse. Also keep all people not directly involved in sling operations out of the work area.

**Environmental:** Steep terrain, Poor Footing, Rolling Rocks Unburned vegetation. Identify hazardous snags in work areas and avoid or remove. Snags will be felled only when they pose a threat to safety. **All snags will fall – the only question is when-** post lookouts if needed

Fight fire aggressively, but provide for safety first.  
Initiate all action based on current and expected fire behavior.  
Recognize current weather conditions and obtain forecasts.  
Ensure instructions are given and understood.

Obtain current information on fire status.  
Remain in communication with crew members, your supervisor, and adjoining forces.  
Determine safety zones and escape routes.  
Establish look outs in potentially hazardous situations.  
Retain control at all times.  
Stay alert, keep calm, think clearly, act decisively.





- Co-ordinate and facilitate appropriate transportation for injured with Medical Unit-EMT in charge of patient(s)
- Nature of Problem    # Inured    Condition & Vitals    Location (GPS coordinates)
- Remove all unnecessary personnel from accident scene
- Secure the scene area and identify witnesses for later investigation.




