Fire Order of the Day – Remain in communications with crewmembers, your supervisor and adjoining forces

Narrative: Areas of moss over bedrock become a pile of wet ash over slippery rock that greatly reduces traction. Watch your footing, look at where you're going to place your feet especially on slopes. Always carry your hand tools in the proper manner, grasped firmly behind the head, carried at waist level. Should you lose your footing, push the tool away from you and release it. Doing this lessens the chance of falling on a sharp tool and injuring yourself.

6. INSTRUCTIONS AND ASSIGNMENTS NOT CLEAR

Look Up, Look Down, Look Around

- ***Fuel Characteristics** – Assess prior to beginning operations.
- ***Fuel Moisture** – Read daily shift plan and assess on site.
- ***Fuel Temperature** – Varies with exposure to direct sunlight.
- ***Terrain & Fuel Accumulations** – Scout prior to beginning operations and continuously during operations.
- ***Wind** – Measure, observe, feel and notice changes.
- ***Atmospheric Stability** – Observe.
- ***Fire Behavior** – Monitor constantly prior to and during operations.
- ***Safety** – Ask questions in unfamiliar situations. The only dumb question is the one you did not ask.







- Co-ordinate and facilitate appropriate transportation for injured with Medical Unit-EMT in charge of patient(s)
- Nature of Problem # Inured Condition & Vitals Location (GPS coordinates)
- Remove all unnecessary personnel from accident scene
- Secure the scene area and identify witnesses for later investigation.

Life safety is the Number 1 Priority on this Incident!
