

6. MEDICAL EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Upon occurrence of a "MAJOR" medical or accident involving significant injury on the fireline, the closest Division Supervisor should respond directly to the scene to take control of the situation and direct necessary actions. If DIVS is unavailable, the **nearest fireline Supervisor or Leader** needs to take charge.

Clear all radio traffic on incident- do **not** use names

Obtain and facilitate nearest EMT's to the scene by contacting radio dispatch or DO (867-445-3209)

Co-ordinate and facilitate appropriate transportation for injured with Medical Unit-EMT in charge of patient(s)

Nature of Problem # Inured Condition & Vitals Location (GPS coordinates)

Remove all unnecessary personnel from accident scene

Secure the scene area and identify witnesses for later investigation.

Life safety is the Number 1 Priority on this Incident!

- If contact can't be made with dispatch contact DO at 867-445-3209

****Radio Operations: Ask the following Questions? ****

- What happened? (Type Force)
- What type of injuries is the patient complaining of?
- Is there any problem with breathing, bleeding or change in level of consciousness?
- If bee sting, are they allergic? Bee stings require Paramedic attention immediately
- No to all Questions Yes to any questions

Minor

Closest Medivac helicopter to the area will be called to transport the worker to the closest Medic station (Fire 85/11- Matrix Camp Fire 15 - 311 Staging) for assessment by medical staff.

Patient should be escorted by First Aider

- Notify Safety Officer

Serious

Closest incident Medic to respond to location with any available aircraft. Approved Medivac helicopter will be used to perform medivac.

Any serious medivac will be brought to Pad #2 at the heliport at the Yellowknife Airport. **Coordinates 62° 28.32N-114° 27.48W** to meet YKFD for transport to Hospital.

Medic staff will triage the worker and will determine need to be seen by a physician.

Dispatch / DO shall confirm medic is aware of need for medivac.

Dispatch will notify Safety Officer at 902-295-0235. If Safety Officer can't be reached call IC at 709-699-2667.

Once medical staff arrive at the hospital, the onboard medical staff shall contact the SO for patient update and condition.

WEATHER SUMMARY:

- On Monday the overall pressure pattern will weaken, but the gradient will remain strong enough to give gusty winds.
- Winds will be easing off in the early evening and become light by mid-evening.
- RH readings Monday is rather uncertain. The Canadian model keeps the values high, while the US model finds some dry air and lowers readings into the mid-thirties. This forecast will give a hybrid solution, but noting values could be a lower than forecast.
- Temperatures will be on the cool side, running several degrees below seasonal.
