WEATHER SUMMARY:

- On Sunday an arctic cold front will push through the complex in the morning.
- The front will move through the northern parts near 6 am, central parts around Yellowknife near 0800 hours and the southern parts near 1000 hours.
- Winds will shift to northerly gusting up to 45 km/h behind the front.
- These gusting winds will continue through the day, and then ease off into the evening.
- The northwest winds will be fairly light into Monday morning, but still with some gustiness.
- Temperatures will be near their highs in the morning, with little change through the afternoon.
- The low into Monday morning will only be a couple of degrees or so above zero.





- Obtain and facilitate nearest EMT's to the scene by contacting radio dispatch or DO (867-445-3209)
- Co-ordinate and facilitate appropriate transportation for injured with Medical Unit-EMT in charge of patient(s)
- Nature of Problem # Inured Condition & Vitals Location (GPS coordinates)
- Remove all unnecessary personnel from accident scene
- Secure the scene area and identify witnesses for later investigation.

Life safety is the Number 1 Priority on this Incident!






